We are training with Team in Training (TNT) for the San Diego International Triathlon on June 28, 2015!



Our kids Rina and Patrick are our inspiration. Rina was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia - Philadelphia Chromosome (ALL Ph+) on May 10, 2013. This is a rare & high risk form of ALL. Only 5% of ALL patients exhibit the Ph+ type. Due to the high risk nature of the disease, the option of a new immune system through a bone marrow transplant was immediately explored. On Sept 17, 2013, Rina underwent a bone marrow transplant after discovering that her only sibling, 3-yr old Patrick beat the 1 in 4 chance of being her perfect marrow match! "Powerful Patrick's" cells allowed for an amazing recovery and gave her a second chance at life forever bonding the two siblings stronger than ever imagined. Rina is now thriving over one year in remission post-transplant. We now pay it forward through our causes including the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society (LLS).

We battled as a family and we each have the scars to prove it. As Rina's parents and caregivers, we were so focused on Rina's survival and Patrick's ability to thrive that we could not take care of ourselves. Training for this triathlon will boost our healing and help us regain our physical and emotional health. 2015 is our year to heal and reclaim our lives and show cancer that it doesn't have our family!


